



## Attorney E-Business Registration Form

Complete and send to the court. Do **not** send to Judici.

It is vital that the court have correct ARDC # and other information in its system for each attorney, because:

- Judici's existing Courtlook service can't show online case files to just any attorney... only the attorney of record. We determine this by comparing the ARDC # and e-mail address in your Judici profile to what the court has.
- As courts roll out e-filing, EFileIL will be querying the court for the attorney of record when determining who gets electronic service. And your ARDC # helps answer that query.
